

Privacy policy

Primeline is responsible for the processing of personal data voluntarily provided by the User.

The information collected regarding Users is only that which is voluntarily provided by Users to contact Primeline through the contact form.

The use and processing of personal data collected on our site is carried out in compliance with REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data. and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

How are personal data collected?

Cookies;

Cookies are used to store information, improving the functionality of the website. Cookies do not give any access to personal information or to your user's computer. They consist only of information that the server places on the visitor's side of the website, making the user be recognized when they visit the same page again and it can be viewed more easily, improving navigability on the part of those who visit a website.

Most browsers allow the use of cookies by default. If desired, browser settings can be changed to prevent them from being used.

However, by preventing the use of cookies, you can compromise the way you interact with this website and with others, Primeline is not responsible for any navigation and interaction problems.

What type of information is collected and how is it used?

In our online store, we collect the name, phone number and e-mail address for booking, contact and quotes. Only Primeline will have access to the personal data provided voluntarily by the users of this website. No personal information will be marketed or provided to other entities.

We may also collect other information about the customer experience on our website that contributes to the improvement of our service.

Right to delete personal data

Please be aware that as a holder of personal data you have the right to obtain from Primeline, as the controller, the deletion of your personal data without undue delay, and the latter has an obligation to delete personal data without undue delay if the data Personal data are no longer needed for the purpose that prompted their collection or treatment or if consent is withdrawn.

Violation of personal data

In the event of a breach of personal data, the controller (Primeline) shall notify the competent supervisory authority (National Data Protection Commission) without undue delay and, whenever possible, within 72 hours of becoming aware of it, unless the breach of personal data is not likely to result in a risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons. If the notification to the supervisory authority is not transmitted within 72 hours, it shall be accompanied by the reasons for the delay.

Whatever the violation of personal data is, Primeline documents it with the following information: the facts related to the data, the effects thereof and the remedial action taken.
